Global VAW Facts

- Up to 7 in 10 women globally will be beaten, raped, abused, or mutilated in their lifetimes –most of this violence takes place in intimate relationships #endvaw
- While 125 countries penalize DV, 603 million women live in States where it's "not a crime" #endvaw

Australia VAW Facts

- Without action, an estimated 3/4 million Australian women will experience violence in 2021-22 #endvaw
- The cost to the Australian economy of violence against women, without action, will rise to an estimated \$15.6 billion by 2021-22 #endvaw
- Physical, social, emotional, psychological, financial impact on women and their children is significant and unacceptable #endvaw
