Australian Women Against Violence Alliance.

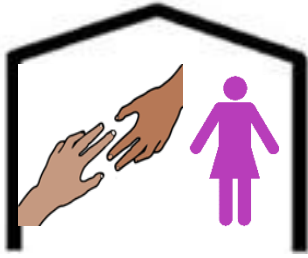
We write **AWAVA** to talk about us.

- Women with Disabilities Australia

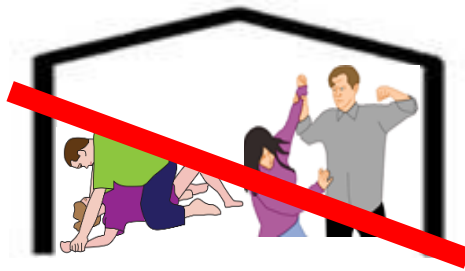


- Harmony Alliance

Like

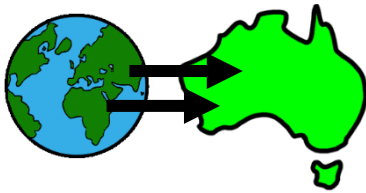
- sex workers

or

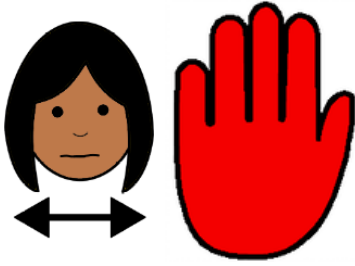


- women who come from another country.



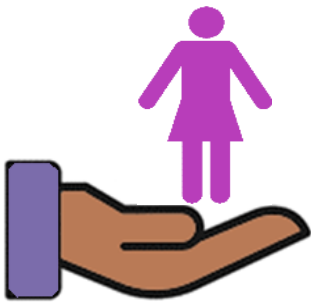
We help us all work together. Like we

- how to stay safe from violence.

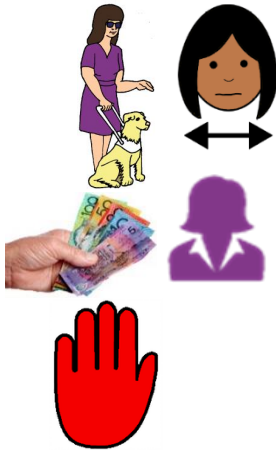


AWAVA wants to make sure
