The person has to leave your home.

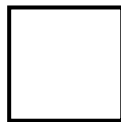


It happened at your work.

The person has to leave your work.



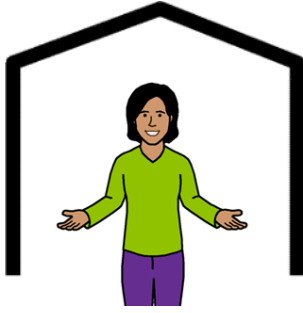
The Court gives you money.
